St John's church is also collecting non-perishable items for local charities if you have any to donate.

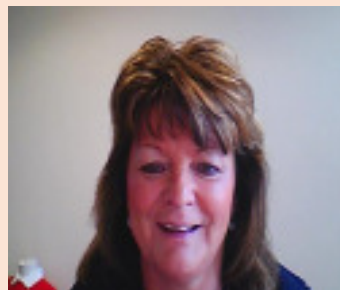
Robinwood Trip

If you can spare an hour on Tuesday to help to do toast for the children, please call into the school office.

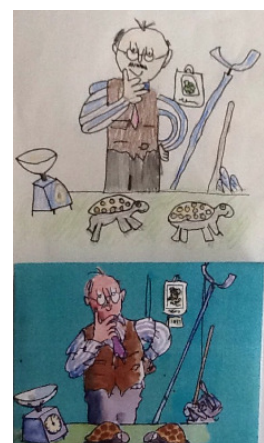
Roald Dahl Day
