ROAD SAFETY

Your child may have to walk to school or the bus stop and back. They may only have to cross the street once. Whatever the case is, you should teach your kids to cross the road safely. Here's how you can help them learn.

Always look for signals and use the pedestrian crossing. In the absence of such markings, here is what you should do:

- Look to your right, then your left to see if there are any approaching vehicles
- If yes, wait for the vehicle to pass and then cross the road
- Never cross at bends
- Never cross between stationary vehicles

Adults should always accompany children aged less than six and hold their hand when crossing the road.
