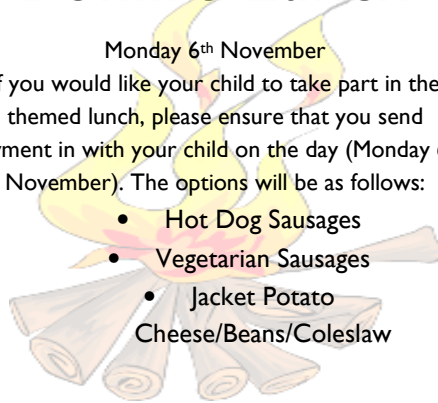


Bonfire Lunch

Children in Need 2017 - Non Uniform Day

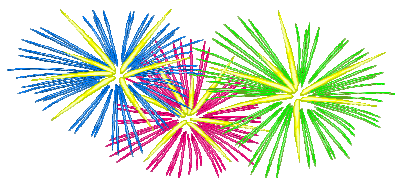
